MAKE YOUR OWN GLASS BEADS

LEARN HOW TO MAKE GLASS BEAD WITH VETERAN BEAD MAKER, MARJ BATES, WHO HAS BEEN MAKING GLASS BEADS SINCE 1993. LEARN THE ANCIENT TECHNIQUE OF GLASS BEAD MAKING KNOWN AS *LAMP WORK*. THE ART INVOLVES MELTING GLASS AROUND A STEEL ROD AND SHAPING IT INTO A BEAD. STUDENTS WILL LEARN HOW TO MELT, SHAPE, COOL HOT GLASS AND HOW TO ADD DECORATIONS AND EMBELLISHMENTS TO THE BEADS. MARJ WILL INTRODUCE THE TECHNIQUES USED TO MAKE HER AWARD WINNING DESIGNS. STUDENTS WILL LEARN STUDIO SAFETY AND HOW TO SET UP A STUDIO IN THEIR SPACE. STUDENTS WILL LEAVE WITH ENOUGH GLASS BEADS TO MAKE A CHERISHED KEEPSAKE. THE WORKSHOP TAKES PLACE IN MARJ'S LIGHT FILLED SEASIDE STUDIO ON LIGHTHOUSE POINT IN SCITUATE HARBOR. SEA GLASS & BEACH STONE JEWELRY WORKSHOP

ONE DAY WORKSHOPS, DATE BELOW

LEARN HOW TO DRILL YOUR FAVORITE CHERISHED PIECES OF SEA GLASS AND TUMBLED BEACH STONES. MAKE EARRINGS, NECKLACE, BRACELETS AND RINGS.

AFTER DRILLING LESSONS STUDENTS WILL LEARN HOW TO CONNECT THEIR DESIGNS WITH COLD CONNECTIONS. STUDENTS WILL USE SILVER WIRE OR SILVER TUBE; STUDENTS WILL EXPLORE BOTH TECHNIQUES. MARJ WILL HAVE DIFFERENT SILVER MATERIALS FOR YOU TO PURCHASE. ALSO LEARN A BASIC WIRE WRAPPING TECHNIQUE WHICH MAY AID YOU IN THE MAKING OF YOUR DESIGNS. MARJ WILL SUPPLY MATERIALS KITS INCLUDING SAMPLES OF SILVER, LEATHER CORD, DRILL BITS, SAFETY GLASSES, AND RESPIRATORS. PLEASE ALLOW \$35 FOR THE COST OF THIS KIT. PLEASE BRING: LUNCH; IDEAS AND PICTURES; FOUND OBJECT TREASURES - SEA GLASS, STONES, SHELLS; FAVORITE TOOLS; A ROTARY TOOL IF YOU HAVE ONE. CLASSES ARE HELD IN MARJ'S SCITUATE HARBOR STUDIO.
