The Duxbury Art Association invites you to apply for the 34th Annual Juried Craft Show and Sale to be held at the Duxbury High School. All work must be handmade using original designs. This delightful holiday event features up to 70 of New England's top artisans, a Gourmet Food Court and attracts over 1,500 visitors annually.

How to Apply:

1. Please complete the application attached and return by Friday, August 18, 2006.
2. Enclose a sample of your craft along with three photos of additional work and one photo of your table/booth. CD's are welcome. No slides please.
3. *New!* You must provide correct return postage (via US Mail or UPS), packaging and insurance (if desired) for any samples you provide. Due to space limitations, artisans will no longer be able to pick up samples at the DAA after jurying.
4. Please include two checks made payable to the Duxbury Art Association:
 - \$10.00 jurying fee (non-refundable donation to the DAA)
 - \$220.00 per 9' x 9' space or \$250 per 10'x10' space (limited) plus any fees for table rentals or electricity as specified on the application

(Note: Applications received without payment will not be juried.)

Please note, entries that do not comply with all of the requirements will not be juried.

Criteria:

Jurors will review entries to ensure work is original and exceptional in quality. Artisans will be selected based on the following criteria:

- Quality of Craftsmanship
- Originality of Design
- Audience Appeal

There is a maximum of 70 booths.

Each artisan must provide a set-up to accommodate a 9' x 9' space.

A limited number of 10' x 10' spaces may be offered. Please check the application box if interested.

All display tables must have a table covering to the floor.

- Applicants must provide their own insurance. DAA will not be responsible for loss or theft.

Notification:

Artisans will be notified by mail of acceptance no later than September 15, 2006. Booth fees will be returned to those applicants not accepted. No refunds will be given after acceptances are mailed.

Please note that acceptance in previous years does not guarantee acceptance this year.
